Sr Kathleen Page, a Daughter of Charity who works with St Joseph’s Services in Rosewell has asked if we would be willing to support their sisters work for Covid patients in Manmad, in the Maharashtra Province: The sisters there write that, *‘the situation is very bad in India. The second wave is affecting the people in different ways. It is affecting directly the lungs without any symptoms and people are dying within no time without getting the oxygen and other medications. Many states are suffering due to the scarcity of oxygen and there is little help for the people. Government is not so supportive of the people.*

The Sisters in normal circumstances work alongside the Karuna Aids Centre (Part of the Karuna Hospital itself a charitable hospital providing care and nursing training in the city of Manmad) There, they support the children of people with AIDS. It is now turned over to the immediate care of people who have Covid 19, like many other parts of the Indian health service it is overwhelmed by this crises. No better way to thank God for our own NHS than to support those who do not have that blessing

All of the money raised will go directly by bank transfer to the Hospital, through the Daughters of Charity, as soon as it is received
